



2010 Philmont Adventure

The Great Rivers Council contingent to Philmont will leave LaPlata, MO on Sunday, July 18, 2010 and return Sunday, August 1, 2010. The total contingent fee will not exceed \$1,000.00.

Philmont is a 137,493-acre working cattle ranch in northeastern New Mexico dedicated to perpetuating the aims of the Boy Scouts of America.

Applications for the adult contingent leadership positions are currently being accepted. Each of the four treks will have an adult advisor. There will also be an overall adult contingent advisor.

28 youth and 8 adult positions exist and fill fast. All participants require the approval of their unit leader as well as that of the contingent leader. Scout participants require parental approval. Scouts must be 14 years old as of January 1, 2010. A \$100 non-refundable non-transferable deposit per person is required. Registrations will not be accepted without a participant's name and parent's permission.

Limited amounts of financial aid are available for those Scouts wishing to attend Philmont, but are not financially able. Due to large demand, preference may be given to those who have NOT attended Philmont in the past. Application for financial aid is due November 1, 2009.
