From St Louis area:

1. I-70 West
2. Take the US-54 Exit (Exit 148) toward Auxvasse/Mexico/Fulton
3. Turn left onto US-54 West
4. Take the Main Street ramp toward the State Capitol
5. Turn left on Main Street
6. Turn right on Missouri Blvd
7. Turn left onto High Street directly after driving under the overpass
8. The capitol will be on your left

From Kansas City and St. Joseph area:

1. I-70 or Highway 36 East
2. Take the US-63/Jefferson City/Moberly exit and follow directions for south (exit 128A off I-70)
3. Merge onto US-63 South
4. Merge onto US-54 West/US-63 South/CF Red Whaley Expressway toward Jefferson City
5. Take the Main Street ramp toward the State Capitol
6. Turn left on Main Street
7. Turn right on Missouri Blvd
8. Turn left onto High Street directly after driving under the overpass
9. The capitol will be on your left

From Springfield:

1. I-44 East
2. Take the 129 Exit Highway 5 north
3. Turn right onto Highway 54 in Camdenton
4. Take the Missouri Blvd Exit toward Jefferson City
5. Turn right onto Missouri Blvd
6. Turn right onto High Street
7. The capitol will be on your left
