The Great Rivers Council contingent to Philmont will leave LaPlata, MO on Friday, July 27th, 2018 and return Friday, August 10th, 2018. The total contingent fee will not exceed \$1,500⁰⁰.

Philmont is a 137,493-acre working cattle ranch in northeastern New Mexico dedicated to perpetuating the aims of the Boy Scouts of America. After 75 years, Philmont continues to have more individuals requesting an opportunity to participate in trekking programs than space allows. Due to large demand, preference may be given to those who have not attended Philmont previously.

Our crew will be formed with a maximum of 12 persons including a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 4 adults. A total of 12 positions exist and fill fast. All participants require the approval of their unit leader as well as that of the GRC contingent leader. Youth participants must be 14 years old *or* have completed the 8th grade prior to leaving for the trek. Youth participants require parental approval. A \$100 *non-refundable non-transferable* deposit per person is required. Registrations will not be accepted without a participant's name and parent's permission.
